At Walmley Junior School the Governing Board meets three times each term and meetings commence at approximately 5.30pm. ### Data Checking Sheets

At parents' evening you were given a data checking sheet for your child and asked to check and update contact details if they have changed. If you have not returned this, please do so to the school office by **Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> November**. If we do not receive the data checking sheet back, we will presume that none of the contact details have changed.

## Whole School Flu Vaccination

We are just waiting for The Immunisation Team to confirm a date to come into school to give the flu vaccine.

## Absence

If your child is absent due to illness, we would ask that you contact the school office **before 9.30 am** on the first day of absence so that we can ensure our records are up to date. We would then ask that you send a letter to your child's class teacher on their return to school. If your child has a medical appointment, please ensure that the school office is made aware in advance. We would ask you to arrange medical appointments outside the school day wherever possible.

**Coronavirus:** The NHS advises that the main symptoms of COVID-19 are:

- a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child has any of the main symptoms:

- Get a test to check if they have coronavirus as soon as possible.
- Stay at home and do not have visitors until you receive your test result – only leave home to have a test.
- Contact the school office to keep us updated on the situation.

If your child seems to have coronavirus symptoms in school, we will isolate them and may check their temperature. We will contact you to arrange for them to be collected from school and advise you to get them tested. If the test result is negative, they should return to school. If the test is positive, your child should self-isolate for at least 10 days, starting from the date they started to show symptoms. They can return to school after this, as long as they feel well enough.

We are asking for payment to be made in advance, this will ensure your child receives a lunch on that day. Payment should be made no later than **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> November.**

## Cake Sale



Payment should be made no later than **Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021**. **Once the deadline date has passed there will be no opportunity to order, so please do not contact the school office to ask.**

## Dinner Money

Dinner money is £12.50 per week (i.e. £2.50 per meal). If you prefer to pay for the half-term in advance, it will be **£85.00** for Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November to Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> December. Please ensure that payments are made promptly using our online system. Outstanding dinner money invoices are sent by email and we wish to remind you that dinner money **should always be paid in advance not arrears**. We hope that your child will have school dinners, but please remember to give the school office one week's notice in writing of any changes to your child's lunch arrangements.

## Water Bottles

Please provide your child with a named water bottle. The children always have access to water and they will need their bottle in school every day to keep them sufficiently hydrated. Please do not send them in with squash. We do have water bottles in the school office which can be purchased for 50p.

## Earlybirds Bookings

A reminder if you need to make an emergency booking it must be made before 12 o'clock on that day. In addition, if you cancel an Earlybirds session after 12 o'clock, you will have to collect your child from Earlybirds as they may have already been taken there by a member of the Earlybirds team.

## Payments to school

Can we please remind parents that we are a cashless school, and all payments should be made using our online payments system <https://www.scopay.com/walmley-jun> We do not hold any cash in school and therefore cannot refund any payments made in cash that subsequently need to be returned. **Please note that any cash payments made that need to be returned will sit on your child's account for you to use for a future trip/event.**

## ScoPay App

Did you know there is a ScoPay App? It allows you to:

- Register your child's ScoPay account.
- Link children to an existing account using either a link code or QR code
- Pay for school meals, clubs and trips and see live balance information
- Link to your mobile calendar to add trip dates
- View payment history/receipts
- Set up alerts to be received by email or in-App for new items online, trip payment deadlines, low account balances
- Manage account information – password, email, billing details, payment agreements
