When your child is in Year 5, they will have the opportunity to take part in a five-day visit to the Outward Bound Centre at Howtown, near Ullswater, in the heart of the Lake District. The children really love the physical and mental challenges they are presented with, and tell us that they will always remember their time there because it is so much fun! With so many missed experiences over the last 2 years, we feel it is more important than ever for our children to have this opportunity and we hope you'll agree!

The Outward Bound Trust is an educational charity that uses the outdoors to provide life-changing educational courses and unique experiences for young people. We often see a real difference in their attitude and maturity upon their return to school.
