## Parents' Evening - Online Appointment Booking

I would like to invite you to attend our Spring Term Parents' Evening on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> or Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> February. This is an important evening where you can speak with the class teacher about the progress your child has made so far this year. It will also be an opportunity for you to ask any questions you may have.

Due to the high numbers of Covid in our school community, we have decided to hold these appointments on an easy-to-use online booking system and for meetings to take place via video link, not in person. This system allows you to choose your own appointment times and you will receive an email confirming your appointment. We feel this will give our families flexibility as well as keeping everyone safe.

Appointments can be made or changed from Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> February at 7am up until the day of your appointment. Should you have any issues booking your appointment, please contact the school office.

The appointments will be held via video link and will be 8 minutes long before the call will automatically end.
