
OUP Trip To Coventry

The Phoenix and the Carpet is the sequel to E. Nesbit's beloved Five Children and It, and the second book in the Psammead trilogy.


When Cyril, Anthea, Robert, Jane and Lamb find a mysterious egg, the adventure of a lifetime begins.

The six Chan children enjoy their life on the Yorkshire Dales. Until 2020 arrives.



So, when Flora and Archie are offered a trip to Craig Glas Castle in Wales, and a break from talking to ghosts, they can't wait to go.


But not everything at the castle is what it seems and soon the best friends embark on another ghostly detective adventure.
