A selection of our objectives:

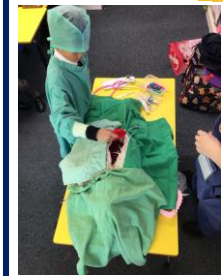
- Writing address and date of birth

This specialist subject is tailor made for Year 3 and Year 4 and enables children to experience the fundamental skills needed in everyday life.

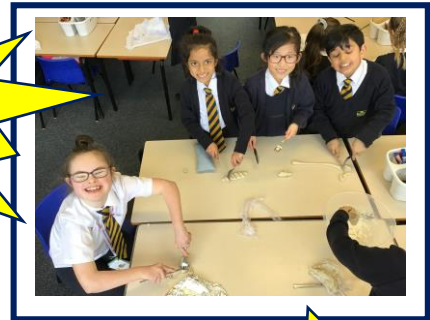

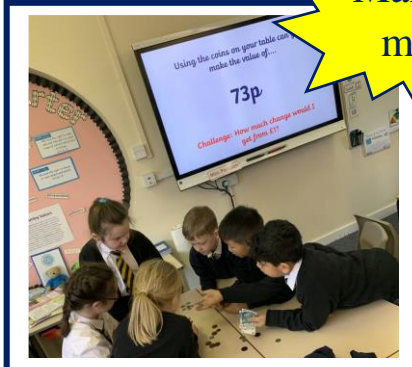
