



## End of Key Stage 2 Assessment Results 2023

This year pupils were given a scaled score from 80 to 120. The expected standard was a scaled score of 100. Our school was moderated by the LA for writing this year.

The national combined standard for pupils who achieved the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics was **59%**. As a school we achieved **88%**.

The national combined standard for pupils which achieved the higher standard in reading writing and mathematics was **8%**. As a school **22%** of pupils achieved this standard.
