Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to offer after school activities for next half term.

Places are allocated on a first come first serve basis as there are limited places for all clubs. To secure a place for your child, you **MUST** pay for the club online by logging onto Schools Cash Office and paying by **Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2024**. Payment will not be accepted in school. Once the club has reached its maximum number, it will disappear from view. This means that if you have successfully paid online, your child has secured a place on that club. **You will need to complete the online form on Scopay prior to payment to book your place, and paper forms do not need to be returned to school.**

#### How long do the clubs run for and how much do they cost?

Please see table below for dates and prices. All clubs will run from 3.30pm until 4.30pm. Please collect the children from the main reception area. **Children will be held for 10 minutes, after that they will be taken to Earlybirds and you will be charged for this service. If you would like your child to attend a club and need financial assistance, then please speak to either Mr Pearson, Mrs Smith, Mrs Conway or Mr. Ware.**

#### Can I sign my child up for more than one club?

Your child is welcome to attend as many clubs as they wish, but please check you are not signing them up to clubs that run on the same day!
