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Late Notifications to school

Can we please ask parents to remember to send a note into the class teacher **on the morning** when they have made alternative arrangements, e.g. another parent is picking a child up, they are not going to Earlybirds, they are not going to a club. We are receiving messages late in the afternoon for arrangements that have been made the night before. Attendance

A polite reminder to all parents to keep routine appointments such as dentist and opticians <u>outside of school hours</u>. If your child is absent from school, you must inform the school office by telephoning to explain why your child is off that day, giving key details including symptoms of illness if they are unwell, <u>by 9.30 am</u> on the first day of the absence. Please help your child to build their resilience and work ethic by sending them to school if they only have a mild cough/cold.

Earlybirds Bookings

A reminder if you need to make an emergency booking, it must be made before 12 o'clock on that day. In addition, if you cancel an Earlybirds session after 12 o'clock, you will have to collect your child from Earlybirds as they may have already been taken there by a member of the Earlybirds team. Please also note that if you wish your child to have breakfast, your child must be in before 8.15 am as breakfast finishes at 8.20 am.

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Hotdog Lunch - Wednesday 26th June

We would like to give the children who normally have sandwiches the opportunity to have a lunch on Wednesday 26th June. If you would like your child to have a lunch, the cost is £2.60. Payment for Hot dog lunches should be made using Scopay online payment system. Hot dog lunch can be found in 'Products' then 'Hot dog lunch'. We are asking for payment to be made in advance; this will ensure your child receives a lunch on that day. Payment should be made no later than Monday 17th June. Please only pay £2.60 for the June Hotdog lunch and refrain from making overpayments as it causes issues on our payment system. If your child normally has a lunch on Wednesdays, you do not need to pay.

Payments to school

Can we please remind parents that we are a cashless school, and all payments should be made using our online payments system https://www.scopay.com/walmley-jun We do not hold any cash in school and therefore cannot refund any payments made in cash that subsequently need to be returned. Please note that any cash payments made, that need to be returned will sit on your child's account for you to use for a future trip/event.

Dinner Money

Dinner money is £13.00 per week (i.e. £2.60 per meal). If you prefer to pay for the half-term in advance, it will be £88.40 for Tuesday 4th June to Friday 19th July. Please ensure that payments are made promptly using our online system. Outstanding dinner money invoices are sent by email and we wish to remind you that dinner money should always be paid in advance not arrears. Please remember if your child has a meal on a Thursday and or Friday and is going to London pay for one or two meals less across the Summer 2 Half Term. We hope that your child will have school dinners, but please remember to give the school office one week's notice in writing of any changes to your child's lunch arrangements. The Summer Term 2 will start on Week 1 of the menus.

Free School Meals

Changes have been made as to how we collect information for Free School Meals. You no longer have to come into school to complete paperwork and bring in evidence as it is all done by simply registering online at https://www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/birmingham. You only ever need to register once and school will automatically be updated of eligibility or any changes of eligibility; this information is data protected as per the terms shown.

Sunny Weather
