School Timings – reminder

Lateness Procedure

If your child is **late in the morning (after 8.55 a.m. when the gate closes)** or you are late collecting them after school, please **accompany them to the office to register their arrival** or collect them in person. If they walk or ride by themselves, please phone school to advise the reason why.

Uniform

Please do not buy new uniform without checking the full list on the school website first. Some children are still being sent in with 'variations' that are not part of our uniform (including coloured socks!). Please do not put your child in the difficult position of being challenged for wearing the wrong uniform — a navy skirt does not include black, and leather/leather look shoes do not include fabric trainers.

Could we also give out the usual reminder about writing your **child's name** in <u>ALL</u> of their clothing and belongings, please, especially lunchboxes, coats and jumpers/cardigans. This will save you money by items not being lost!

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Attendance

A reminder to all parents that if your child is absent from school, you must inform the school office by telephoning to explain why your child is off that day, giving key details including symptoms of illness if they are unwell, <u>by 9.30am</u> on the first day of the absence. Please help your child to build their resilience and work ethic by sending them to school if they only have a mild cough/cold.

Earlybirds Bookings

A reminder if you need to make an emergency booking, it must be made before 12 o'clock on that day. In addition, if you cancel an Earlybirds session after 12 o'clock, you will have to collect your child from Earlybirds as they may have already been taken there by a member of the Earlybirds team.

Childcare Vouchers

Can we please remind all parents who pay by **vouchers** that there are HMRC rules and regulations that providers and school have to follow regarding vouchers. School should not be receiving payments that would put a child's account in credit. As per the email that is issued with your statement each month <u>please only activate your voucher to match the amount owing. The statement is provided so you have the necessary information to hand when activating your voucher.</u>

Toast sales will start w/c Tuesday 3rd September. Payment should be paid in advance using Scopay online payment. Toast can be found under 'Products' then 'toast'. We are asking for payment to be made in advance for the Summer Term only, this will ensure your child receives toast on their nominated day. For the whole of the Autumn Term the cost will be £6.00 but for Year 3 it will be £5.60 due to the INSET day on Monday 2nd September. Payment should be made no later than Friday 30th August. Once the deadline date has passed, there will be no opportunity to order, so please do not contact the school office to ask. As we are sure you can appreciate Mrs Bean has to ensure she has the necessary supplies which is why we have a deadline.

Hotdog Lunch - Wednesday 25th September

We would like to give the children who normally have sandwiches the opportunity to have a lunch on Wednesday 25th September. If you would like your child to have a lunch, the cost is £2.70. **Payment for Hotdog lunches should be made using Scopay online payment system.** Hotdog lunch can be found in 'Products' then 'Hotdog lunch'. We are asking for payment to be made in advance; this will ensure your child receives a lunch on that day. Payment should be made no

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later than Monday 16th September. Please only pay £2.70 for the September Hotdog lunch and refrain from making overpayments as it causes issues on our payment system. <u>If your child normally has a lunch on a Wednesday, you do</u> not need to pay

Payments to school

Can we please remind parents that we are a cashless school, and all payments should be made using our online payments system https://www.scopay.com/walmley-jun We do not hold any cash in school and therefore cannot refund any payments made in cash that subsequently need to be returned. Please note that any cash payments made, that need to be returned will sit on your child's account for you to use for a future trip/event.

Dinner Money - Price Increase by 10p

Dinner money will be increasing by 10p per meal from September 2024 to £13.50 per week (i.e. £2.70 per meal). If you prefer to pay for the half-term in advance, it will be £105.30 for Tuesday 3rd September to Friday 25th October. Please ensure that payments are made promptly using our online system. Outstanding dinner money invoices are sent by email and we wish to remind you that dinner money should always be paid in advance not arrears. We hope that your child will have school dinners, but please remember to give the school office one week's notice in writing of any changes to your child's lunch arrangements. There will be new menus for the Autumn Term available on our website shortly and we will start on Week 1 of the menus in September.

Free School Meals

Changes have been made as to how we collect information for Free School Meals. You no longer have to come into school to complete paperwork and bring in evidence as it is all done by simply registering online at https://www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/birmingham. You only ever need to register once and school will automatically be updated of eligibility or any changes of eligibility; this information is data protected as per the terms shown.
