Year 3 – Woodlands Trip

We are pleased to inform you that a day visit to Woodlands Camp in Streetly has been arranged for our Year 3 children. This will take place on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> May 2025.

Woodlands Camp is a long established centre, well used by many Birmingham Schools, which offers children of all ages the opportunity to experience a wide variety of outdoor activities. The National Curriculum includes outdoor activities as an integral part of Physical Education and Woodlands Camp offers an excellent introduction to such activities for young children. We have taken our Year 3 children there many times and they have tremendous fun!

On the day of their visit, we will leave school at 9.15 am and return to school at approximately 4.15 pm. The activities will include; archery, zipwire, double-hulled canoeing and orienteering. All children will be required to wear a life jacket and helmet during the water activity, which the centre provides. All instruction in the activities will be given by fully qualified members of staff at the centre. If you have any queries or questions about the activities, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher

The children will need to be dressed in suitable (old) clothing for the activities and bring a packed lunch with a drink. A clothes list will be sent out nearer the time.

The cost of the trip is £49.00 which includes activities at the centre, insurance and transport by coach. Please pay using our online payment system Scopay. You will have already received the Online Account Access letter with your one-time link code when we sent out the Transition letter in May.

Payment should be received by 21<sup>st</sup> March 2025. If there are not enough voluntary contributions the trip will not go ahead. Please contact the school office if you have any queries or concerns with regards to payment for this.
