As part of our creative curriculum, Year 4 will be going on a trip to Coventry on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2025 to visit Coventry Cathedral and The Herbert Art Gallery and Museum. They will have the opportunity to learn more about the history of the city and explore some key themes based on peace, conflict and reconciliation (linked to R.E. lessons).
