Dear Parents/Carers,

Before Year 6 SATs

In May, your child will be completing their end of Key Stage 2 SATs. We have all been working hard throughout the year to ensure that your child is ready and able to demonstrate what they have learnt during their time in KS2. We would also like to thank you for supporting your child with regular reading and maths homework.

Before the Easter break, your child will complete a mock SATs week. This is so that they all know exactly what to expect and to reassure them. It will also inform their teachers about what they still need to work on during the remaining weeks of revision.

Over the Easter break, we will be sending home a SATs pack for your child to complete. This is so they can continue to practise the skills they need. However, it is also important to have a balance; they should all have time to relax, play and enjoy time with their family and friends.

On return to school after the Easter break, children will be having revision lessons, with a focus on wellbeing at the end of each day. Please ensure your child's attendance is excellent during this time, as far as possible, and support your child with a good bedtime routine.

During the week of SATs, we would like to invite all Year 6 children to come into school from 8.30am to begin their day in a calm way. We will be offering breakfast of cereals, toast and fruit juice - free of charge.
